	Instructor Module 1. \$300. This is an intense weekend. Please set aside two full days; there will also be homework!
•	Planning a Practice: A practice lesson plan will be reviewed on Day One and analyzed in a group setting on Day Two. Analyzing Performance will be integrated into the practical lessons
•	Teaching a Lesson Topic: Participants will teach a lesson topic (issued on registration) to volunteer students/horses in a mock evaluation setting. The standard will be reviewed and feedback on performance will be provided. All students in this module will receive different lesson topics.
	Instructor Module 2. \$90. A half day.
•	Lunge a horse (English)
•	Participants will bring their own lunging horse/equipment (or arrange to rent a horse) and lunge in a mock evaluation setting. The standard will be reviewed and feedback on performance will be provided.
	Lunge a Rider (Western)
•	Participants will bring their own lunging horse/equipment (or arrange to rent a horse) and lunge in a mock evaluation setting. The standard will be reviewed and feedback on performance will be provided.
	Instructor Module 3. \$90. A half day
•	Stable Management
	Participants will review the stable management requirements for the Instructor stream. Participants will be required to bring polo wraps, stable/standing wraps, shipping wraps, and a tail wrap. Their stable management skills will be evaluated in a mock, group evaluation setting.

To complement these modules, the Equestrian Theory Classroom Workshop will be offered January 6th and 13, 2019.

Competition Coach Module 1. \$175 1 day

Planning a Lesson

A practice lesson plan will be developed on Day One and analyzed in a group setting on Day Two.
