



Heritage Classic Show Circuit Outline For Horse Show Committees

- Obtain a Heritage Handbook from the Manitoba Horse Council Office. Review the rules, regulations and guidelines.
- Select from the Heritage Handbook those divisions/classes that match the classes offered in your Horse Show Prize List (ensure that they have the same age requirements). Indicate (by an H or a symbol of your choice) on your Horse Show Prize List which classes are Heritage Classic Classes in which horse and riders can collect points.
- Obtain a Heritage Classic Horse Show permit, for a cost of \$50.00, from the Manitoba Horse Council Office, display it in your show office during your show.
- Horse/Rider combinations, (prior to participating in any Heritage Class the riders must complete a Heritage Classic Nomination Form and obtain a Heritage Record Book from the Manitoba Horse Council Office, they also must be a current MHC member) will enter the Heritage Classes.
- Riders will record their placings in their Heritage Classic Record Books (which will be obtained by the rider from the Manitoba Horse Council Office), and have an official from the Horse Show Committee (preferably the show secretary) sign their record book on the appropriate page to confirm the placing.
- Complete the Heritage Classic Circuit Results Form and send it to the MHC office.
- For the 2015 horse show season there will not be a Championship show. Awards will be given provincially to champions and reserve champions in the youth and senior age categories in each of the Sport Regions.
