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## How to Record Your Placings

To ensure that you are credited with all of your qualifying placings, simply follow the steps below:

1. Enter your name, your horse's name (only one horse/exhibitor combination per record book) and your age group into this Record Book.
2. When you arrive at a competition, enter and compete as you would normally do. If you receive a qualifying placing (1<sup>st</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup>) in any of your designated Heritage Classes, write it down in this Record Book. Remember to do this after each class so that you can keep an accurate record of your day's achievements.
3. When you have finished your classes for the day, take this Record Book to the show office. At the show office have the secretary sign your Record Book in the appropriate spaces next to your recorded placings.
4. When you have completed the horse show season please return your completed Heritage Record Book to the MHC office before October 1<sup>st</sup>.

Keep in mind:

1. The show secretary will also be keeping a record of all Heritage Classes and placings. These records will be cross-checked with the record books by the MHC office, to ensure accuracy.
2. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to maintain this Record Book and to have their Record Book signed before the close of the competition.

3. Enjoy yourself! We guarantee that you will have the opportunity to meet new friends and have a good time. If you have any questions, please don't hesitate to contact the Manitoba Horse Council office.

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## Rules of Competition

To Qualify for the Manitoba Heritage Classic Circuit:

1. You must be a resident of Manitoba.
2. You must be a current member in good standing with the Manitoba Horse Council.
3. A horse and exhibitor combination must compete in at least 4 different Heritage sanctioned competitions prior to October 1<sup>st</sup>.
4. A horse may be qualified by only one exhibitor.
5. Each Record Book will be registered in joint names of one horse and exhibitor combination and is non-transferable.
6. Heritage sanctioned competitions will be governed by the sponsoring club or association in matter of rules, entry fees, etc.
7. Juniors competitors are age 17 and under as of January 1<sup>st</sup>. Senior competitors are over 17 years of age as of January 1<sup>st</sup>. Please note that some shows will not use the same age categories, in this instance, and in open sanctioned competitions, placings will be credited in the recognized age category of the competitor for purposes of the Heritage Classic Show Circuit.
8. It is the responsibility of the competitor to be familiar with the applicable show rules and Heritage Handbook rules.
