Information Storage

Manitoba Horse Council's staff, Board and volunteers take seriously the trust that you place in us. To prevent unauthorized access or disclosure, to maintain data accuracy and to ensure appropriate use of your information, MHC utilizes appropriate physical, technical and administrative procedures to safeguard the information collected. Information is protected from unauthorized access and kept only as long as reasonably required. Your personal membership information will not be sold or leased to third parties. Your personal membership information – excluding payment information -- will be provided to Equestrian Canada for the purposes outlined below.

Equestrian Canada National Membership Fee

MHC remains in acceptance of the Equestrian Canada (EC) National reform and Service agreements and is officially a participating province with EC. Introduced in 2010, EC now implements its own membership fee on each provincial member in all participating provinces. This separate fee ensures each person has mandatory membership with EC as the National body for equestrianism in Canada. In addition, it allows EC, as the National body, access to all MHC members' details with MHC permission (**excluding payment information**) in order for EC to better serve provincial members – recreational and competitive – through opportunities for direct communication.

All EC membership fees collected by MHC are held in trust. MHC submits the EC fees collected directly to Equestrian Canada at a specified point during the year. The funds EC receives from its membership fee are used to improve EC services as the National body. **Note that the EC membership fee is separate from EC Sport Licenses and any other EC fee or charge.**

Notice

1. Insurance policies for members in good standing with MHC are valid from January 1, 2017 or the date purchased thereafter and expire December 31, 2017.
2. MHC reserves the right to use the name and/or photograph of its members in the MHC e-newsletter and in articles or reports of activities in the news media or on the web.
3. MHC members in good standing are also members in good standing with Equine Canada provided appropriate payment has been submitted to MHC on behalf of both parties (MHC and EC fees paid in full).

Membership Classifications

Senior Membership

- 18+ on January 1, 2017 (\$55 membership fee + \$5.50 EC fee = \$60.50).

Junior Membership

- Under 18 on January 1, 2017 (\$45 membership fee + \$4.50 EC fee = \$49.50)

Family Membership

- **\$121** for the first two members (\$110 MHC fee + \$11 per family EC membership fee) – the first two members can be two seniors, or a junior and a senior – plus **\$20** for each additional junior after the first two members.
- **A Family membership can now also consist of grandparents and grandchildren.**

Golden Membership

- Reduced rate membership (\$45.00 + \$4.50 EC fee = \$49.50) for individuals over the age of 70 as of January 1st, 2017.
- Includes all benefits with the exception of Accidental Death & Dismemberment insurance coverage; policy maximum is age 70. All other benefits and insurance benefits apply.
- Note that those over age 70 may also apply for a Family membership (grandparents and grandchildren) as per above.

Friends of Horses Membership

- Reduced rate membership (\$25.00 + \$2.50 EC fee = \$27.50) intended for individuals who are non-riders/non-drivers/non-competitors, who are not active in daily equine activities, or who are volunteers.
- Includes liability insurance benefits only. No other benefits apply.

Temporary Membership (Temporary Event/Competition Fee)

Must be purchased from:

- Either the MHC office OR the show organizer prior to participating in the event/competition.
 - Show organizers must submit completed forms and appropriate payment to MHC promptly after the event/competition.
- Provides liability insurance coverage to the individual for the event/competition for which the membership was purchased only. No other benefits apply. (\$35 per event)

Recreation Membership

- A new Recreation membership was introduced at the 2013 Council of Clubs Meeting. Due to insurance standards and policies a separate registration has been developed. Recreation Members and Recreation Family Members are offered memberships at a reduced rate, have excellent insurance benefits and are able to participate in some programs specifically for recreation members. (\$35.00 + \$3.50 EC fee = \$38.50) – Junior or Senior membership / \$77 family + \$20 for each junior add on)

Extended Membership

MHC will offer an extended membership for those applying or renewing after August 31, 2017 (4 months remaining in the membership period). The extended membership information is on the website. (\$75.50 for seniors/ \$49.50 for Pony Clubbers or new juniors)

MHC Member Liability

Who: All current members in good standing with MHC

Amount:

\$5,000,000 Personal Liability insurance

\$ 2,500 Medical Expenses

What: Third-party liability insurance defends against lawsuits and/or settlements for bodily injury or property damage arising out of the non-commercial ownership and/or leasing of horses in the event that no other insurance is in effect. (Eg. If your horse were to cause harm to a third party). This policy will act as an excess coverage if any other insurance is in place. This policy is valid worldwide.

MHC Accidental Death & Dismemberment (Member-only coverage)

Who: All current members under the age of 70 in good standing with MHC

Amount: \$25,000 Accidental Death & Dismemberment

What: Reimbursement to members who may become injured during horse-related sanctioned events under the supervision and at the direction of the Manitoba Horse Council, as well as during any horse-related activities including practice, training, and pleasure riding while not in attendance at a MHC sanctioned event. This policy is valid worldwide.

Notice of any serious injury to a member must be given immediately or your coverage may become null and void. In order to be eligible for coverage under this program, the accident must have occurred while participating in a Manitoba Horse Council sanctioned event or other equine activity as outlined above.

MHC Specified Perils Horse Insurance (Member-only coverage)

Who: All uninsured horses owned by current members in good standing with MHC

Amount: Should a loss occur, maximum limit of \$10,000 per member if your horse is uninsured

What: If your horse is uninsured, this coverage protects your horse from the perils of fire, lightning, earthquake, flood, tornado, drowning, attack by wild animals, collapse of building/bridge, and collision/sinking/overturning of a conveying vehicle. This policy is valid in Canada and continental United States.

This coverage must include bodily injury coverage for participants.

Membership with Equestrian Canada

All Manitoba Horse Council (MHC) members in good standing are members of Equine Canada (EC) and join horse enthusiasts across the country supporting the interests of equestrian sport, recreation and industry. All MHC members are eligible to apply for Equestrian Canada Competitive Sport Licenses, enter into EC Rider Levels, Coaching, and Official Certification and Recognition programs, purchase EC Horse Passports, and access other EC programs.

EC Sponsor Program

All MHC members in good standing and therefore members of Equestrian Canada (EC) have access to excellent discounts through the EC sponsors. This is for ALL MHC members, not just EC Sport License holders. The sponsors and their discounts are listed on the EC website.

MHC also has sponsors that offer discount promotions. These are identified in our newsletters and on the website.

Sport Manitoba

Grants

Sport Manitoba is our major funding partner and support. All MHC members are eligible to apply for Sport Manitoba grants. Grants are available for Athletes, Coaches, Officials, and Course Designers. Check out our website and/or contact the MHC Office for more details.

Other Services

All MHC members have access to Sport Manitoba Print Shop Services at a discounted rate and access to Sport Manitoba meeting rooms at no charge provided the use is for equestrian sport-related activities. Contact the MHC Office for more details.

 - This feature allows MHC members access to Ring 5 on Tuesdays and Wednesdays between May 1st - September 30th
 - No jumping or lessons allowed. Standard arena etiquette applies.

() \$2,500 Emergency Life Saving Surgery Endorsement: \$49.00

This extension to your Horse Mortality (Specified Perils) policy covers emergency, life-saving surgical procedures that take place under a general anesthetic, including colic and fracture repair. The limit per horse / procedure / aggregate per member per membership term is \$2,500 regardless of the number of horses you own or the number or cost of surgeries performed. There is no deductible, and there is no age limit. This extension does not cover surgery related to birthing, dental, arthritic changes, or bone chip removal, and it does not apply to conditions that existing prior to the purchase of coverage. This Policy is valid in Canada and continental United States.

() \$3,500 Tack and Horse Equipment Coverage: \$29.00

Tack and horse equipment you own (excluding rider clothing and protective equipment) is insured against loss or damage, subject to standard exclusions detailed in the policy. The limit per claim / aggregate per member per membership term is \$3,500 regardless of the value of the equipment lost or damaged, and is subject to a \$500 deductible. Claims are settled on an Actual Cash Value basis. This policy is valid in Canada and continental United States.
