The Certified English Instructor provides riders with an introduction to English riding in a fun and safe environment. There is a focus on

The Instructor evaluates the Flat skills involved in Rider Levels 1 to 4 (English); they do not take students to Equestrian Canada sanctioned competitions. There is also an option to certify as an Instructor With Jump who evaluates Flat and Jump skills involved in English Levels 1 to 4.

Full Evaluation including Jump Component:	\$400
Not including Jump Component	\$350
Jump Component only / Any single outstanding component	\$100

Please see registration details for the prerequisites to be completed prior to evaluation. As soon as your registration and payment is received in MHC's office, you will be assigned Lesson Plan Topics to be completed and received in the office by October 25 latest. (Instructor: 1 Unmounted + 1 Flat Lesson Plan + 3rd Mounted Lesson Plan for Jump if that component is to be evaluated.) Emergency Action Plan is also required. All attendees must be members of Manitoba Horse Council or other PTSO, and must pre-register.
