# COACH CAMP

## ***INSTRUCTOR MODULES***

These are practical “hands on” modules designed to prepare participants to be evaluated as Equestrian Canada Instructors/Coaches.

### **WHO SHOULD ATTEND?**

Potential Instructors who wish to start their coaching career, or who have already completed some of the modules prior to being certified as Instructors and teach Equestrian Canada Rider Levels. Modules will be taught by a current Equestrian Canada Coach.



**Instructor Module 1.** \$300. This is an intense weekend. Please set aside two full days; there will also be homework!

- **Planning a Practice:** A practice lesson plan will be reviewed on Day One and analyzed in a group setting on Day Two. Analyzing Performance will be integrated into the practical lessons
- **Teaching a Lesson Topic:** Participants will teach a lesson topic (issued on registration) to volunteer students/horses in a mock evaluation setting. The standard will be reviewed and feedback on performance will be provided. All students in this module will receive different lesson topics.



**Instructor Module 2.** \$90. A half day.

- **Lunge a horse (English)**  
Participants will bring their own lunging horse/equipment (or arrange to rent a horse) and lunge in a mock evaluation setting. The standard will be reviewed and feedback on performance will be provided.
- **Lunge a Rider (Western )**  
Participants will bring their own lunging horse/equipment (or arrange to rent a horse) and lunge in a mock evaluation setting. The standard will be reviewed and feedback on performance will be provided.



**Instructor Module 3.** \$90. A half day

- **Stable Management**  
Participants will review stable management requirements. Participants will be required to bring materials for the following bandages; polo, stable/standing, shipping and tail. Their stable management skills will be evaluated in a mock, group evaluation setting.

To complement these modules, the Equestrian Theory Classroom Workshop will be offered January 5<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup>, 2020

## COMPETITION COACH MODULES

- **Planning a Lesson**

A practice lesson plan will be developed on Day One and analyzed in a group setting on Day Two.

- **Advanced Analyzing Performance** will be integrated into the practical lessons.

- **Teaching for Competition**

Participants will teach a lesson topic (issued on registration) to volunteer students/horses. The standard will be reviewed and feedback on performance will be provided. All students in this module will receive different lesson topics. The lesson topics will not be evaluated but points of interest will be discussed.



### **Competition Coach Module 2.** \$175 1 day

- **Teach a Rider to lunge a horse**

Participants will bring their own lunging horse/equipment (or arrange to rent a horse) and lunge in a mock evaluation setting. The standard will be reviewed and feedback on performance will be provided.

## **COMPETITION COACH SPECIALIST MODULES**

### **WHO SHOULD ATTEND?**

Potential Competition Coach Specialists who wish to further their coaching career, or who have already completed some of the modules prior to being certified as Competition Coach Specialists.

They will be taught by current Equestrian Canada Coach.

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### **Competition Coach Specialist Module 1**    \$90 ½ day

- **Design A Sport Program**

Designing a yearly training program for human and equine athletes.

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### **Competition Coach Specialist Module 2**    \$90 ½ day

- **Lunging a Horse for Improvement**

Lunge a horse to improve performance.

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### **Competition Coach Specialist Module 3**    \$175 1 day

- **Teaching for Competition**

Participants will teach a lesson topic (issued on registration) to volunteer students/horses. The standard will be reviewed and feedback on performance will be provided. All students in this module will receive the same lesson topic. The lesson topic will not be evaluated but points of interest will be discussed.

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### **Competition Coach Specialist Module 4**    \$175 1 day

- **Managing a Sport Program and Training Mental Skills**

Managing the administrative aspects and overseeing the logistics of a sport program. Training mental skills for athletes in a sport program.

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
