# COACH CAMP INSTRUCTOR MODULES

#### WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

Potential Instructors who wish to start their coaching career, or who have already completed some of the modules prior to being certified as Instructors and teach Equestrian Canada Rider Levels. Modules will be taught by a current Equestrian Canada Coach.
Equestrian Canada Coach.
Instructor Module 1. \$300. This is an intense weekend. Please set aside two full days; there will also be homework!
• <b>Planning a Practice:</b> A practice lesson plan will be reviewed on Day One and analyzed in a group setting on Day Two. Analyzing Performance will be integrated into the practical lessons
• <b>Teaching a Lesson Topic:</b> Participants will teach a lesson topic (issued on registration) to volunteer students/horses in a mock evaluation setting. The standard will be reviewed and feedback on performance will be provided. All students in this module will receive different lesson topics.
Instructor Module 2. \$90. A half day.
<ul> <li>Lunge a horse (English)</li> </ul>
Participants will bring their own lunging horse/equipment (or arrange to rent a horse) and lunge in a mock evaluation setting. The standard will be reviewed and feedback on performance will be provided.
Lunge a Rider (Western )
Participants will bring their own lunging horse/equipment (or arrange to rent a horse) and lunge in a mock evaluation setting. The standard will be reviewed and feedback on performance will be provided.
Instructor Module 3. \$90. A half day
Stable Management
Participants will review stable management requirements. Participants will be required to bring materials for the following bandages; polo, stable/standing, shipping and tail. Their stable management skills will be evaluated in

A practice lesson plan will be developed on Day One and analyzed in a group setting on Day Two.
