# **Registration details**

## Prerequisites to be completed prior to the Western Competition Coach Evaluation are:

- Be at least 18 years of age as of January 1, 2020.
- Have completed Equestrian Canada Western Intermediate Basic Training.
- Have a current
  - MHC membership
  - Equestrian Canada Bronze license
  - Standard First Aid Certificate with CPR
- Have completed
  - Make Ethical Decisions online evaluation
  - Making Headway online course
  - o Respect In Sport (with results "shared" with MHC through profile authorization)
  - Waiver and Release form.
  - Equestrian Canada Codes of Ethics and Conduct signed and submitted to MHC Office.
  - Criminal Record Search report (including Vulnerable Sector) and Child Abuse Registry Check)

## Although not pre-requisites the following preparation is highly recommended:

EC NCCP Equestrian Theory Course

Please note, hard copies of pre-requisites must be attached to your registration form if these are not already on file with the office. Phone pictures are not accepted.

**Upon registration**, two teaching topics will be assigned (1 lesson on the Rail and 1 lesson on a Maneuver). A full Lesson Plan for each topic plus an accompanying EAP (Emergency Action Plan) must be handed in by 4:00 p.m. March 5.

NOTE: Competition Coaches will not be eligible to evaluate Rider Testing until they have attended a PSO sponsored Rider Level Evaluator clinic.

Current Coggins and shots will be required for incoming horses.
