



Coaching Camp October 8-10, 2021 Registration deadline September 27th, 2021



An array of valuable sessions covering both the theory skills and practical coaching skills needed for those going forward for Instructor and Coach Evaluations. Emergency Action Plan, Writing a Lesson Plan, Yearly Training Plan are all covered to prepare you. Multi-level sessions for Instructor, Competition Coach, and Competition Coach Specialist, both English and Western, are provided in a mix of online and in-person classes. Includes in-person lunging and coaching opportunities. Dependent on registration, in-person sessions will be offered in Brandon and/or Winnipeg areas. Travel grants are available through Sport Manitoba.

All attendees will be required to comply with Manitoba Covid mandates current on the day of the event(s).

Instructor, Competition Coach participants are encouraged to bring their own lunging horses to make sure they are appropriate. Competition Coach Specialist participants may bring one of their own students and their horse for their equitation lesson. A small stabling day fee may apply depending on the facility.

Registrants who are certified EC Coaches and/or who have already completed the online Equestrian Theory course are not required to attend the Emergency Action Plan, Lesson Planning or Rubrics elements and may deduct \$75 (\$78.75 after tax) from their chosen package.
