What is the purpose of a dressage judge?

A dressage judge is a certified official, responsible for evaluating the performance of dressage tests at a competition .



What is judging?

Making an informed/knowledgeable assessment of the training shown by horse and rider for the test level presented .



Judge's Duties

- > Insure the performance arena is correct and safe
- > Evaluate each test, giving scores for each movement and comments for the movement when considered helpful.
- > Assisting the show committee with competition decisions, enforcement or conflicts .



JUDGES HELP BY

- Guiding the riders' training skills by indicating their strengths
- Giving constructive comments to assist in the advancement of their training and
- Understanding the requirements of each portion of their test .



JUDGES HELP BY

- Protecting the welfare of horses and riders , insuring that horses and riders are treated with respect and compassion and...
- That horses are never subjected to mistreatment or caused undue stress .



QUALITIES OF A JUDGE

- Must be thoroughly competent in their knowledge of dressage and dressage training.
- Must have integrity, accountability & compassion
- Must be able to assess quickly
- Know the training scale



QUALITIES OF A JUDGE

- Know the scale of marks and their corresponding meaning
- Be able to quickly form brief and helpful <u>comments to guide</u> the riders
- Must be positive and passionate about dressage to encourage the love of dressage riding and training.
